RESTRICTED FIRE SEASON REVOKED TO AN OPEN FIRE SEASON

Fire and Emergency New Zealand revokes the restricted fire season in the following areas, which are now in an open fire season:

- Wairoa District,
- Hastings District,
- Napier City
- Central Hawkes Bay District

Except for the Bay Forests Zones and land administered by the Department of Conservation.

The revocation of the restricted fire season and the change to an open fire season is effective from 8am on the 8th April 2019.

An open fire season allows fires to be lit in the open air, without a fire permit.

The Bay Forests Zone and land administered by the Department of Conservation remain in a restricted fire season.

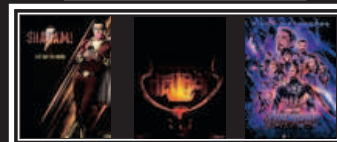
