Rongomaiwahine has secured funding from the Ministry for Environment to develop a plan for Freshwater for the whole of Mahia. This is a combined Iwi and community project.

This will produce a long-term plan to look after our streams, estuaries, wetlands, water in our soil, springs, and aquifers, and all the birds, plants, creatures, and people that depend on this water.

The project will take another 8 months starting with understanding our freshwater today and the issues, developing new ideas and solutions and then agreeing on the action, resources, and funding to make it happen.

The project will involve a lot of research, hui, and wananga and we are establishing a Steering Group and Mahia Advisory Team to contribute to the project.

**Management of Customary Fishing**

*Tāngata Kaitiaki/Tiaki Cancellation of Appointments and new Appointments – Moremore Mātaitai Reserve and Ngai Te Ruruku o Te Rangi rohe moana.*

At the request of Ngai Te Ruruku o Te Rangi, the Minister for Oceans and Fisheries has confirmed the following cancellations and appointments:

**Moremore Mātaitai Reserve:**

- The appointment of Ranui Toatoa as a tangata kaitiaki/tiaki has been cancelled; and
- Tiwana Aranui has been appointed as a replacement tangata kaitiaki/tiaki.

**Ngai Te Ruruku o Te Rangi rohe moana – from Waikare River mouth to Bluff Hill, at Napier.**

- The appointment of Ranui Toatoa as a tangata kaitiaki/tiaki has been cancelled; and
- Tiwana Aranui has been appointed as a replacement tangata kaitiaki/tiaki.

**Ngai Te Ruruku o Te Rangi rohe moana – Tiwhanui area, from Waikare River mouth to Tiwhanui**

- The appointment of Harry Tuapawa as a tangata kaitiaki/tiaki has been cancelled; and
- Henare Waihape has been appointed as a replacement tangata kaitiaki/tiaki.

Tāngata kaitiaki/tiaki appointed for the Ngai Te Ruruku o Te Rangi rohe moana may authorise any individual to take fisheries resources, which are managed under the Fisheries Act 1996, for customary food-gathering purposes. Customary food-gathering may not take place in this area without an authorisation from a tāngata kaitiaki/tiaki.
