The Board also calls upon such of its beneficiaries as have not yet already enrolled, being persons who have attained the age of 18 years, to apply to have their names, occupations and addresses (and also the section or division of the beneficiaries to which they are entitled to belong), included in the Board's roll of beneficiaries.

Any enrolled beneficiary who has changed his or her occupation or address since he or she enrolled is also requested to give the Board notice thereof.

The last day for receiving nominations and applications for enrolment is on 08 April 2024 at 12.00pm, being three months before the present members cease to hold office.

Printed nomination forms can be obtained from the Board's Secretary.

The forms must be signed by at least five (5) beneficiaries who are entitled to vote in respect of the election of that candidate, and be accepted by the candidate, and all signatures witnessed by one or more other adult persons.

A candidate may at any time withdraw his or her nomination by notice to the Board (if the same candidate is nominated for more than one division or section of the Board, the candidate shall give notice to the Board's Secretary electing which division or section he or she will stand for and shall withdraw his or her nomination in respect of the other or others).

An election will be held by postal ballot if the number of valid nominations received by closing date for (by section or division of) the Board exceeds the number of persons required to be elected.
